



FUSION ACADEMY CLUB OFFICIAL CODE OF CONDUCT

CLUB EXPECTATIONS

Fusion Netball Club expects that any persons acting as an official or representative of the club will at all times abide by the following guidelines:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all others;
- Operate within the rules and spirit of the game;
- Make the experience for all athletes and club officials a positive one;
- Display respect and professionalism;
- Ensure all interactions with athletes physical and verbal, are appropriate to the situation and applied to the athlete's skill development;
- Represent Fusion Netball Club with dignity and sportsmanlike behaviour;
- Abide by the Netball Australia Coach Code of Conduct.

CLUB OFFICIAL AIM AND ETHOS

As a representative of Fusion Netball Club you are expected to comply with this Policy.

1. Treat all persons with respect and courtesy and have proper regard for their dignity, rights and obligations.
2. Be ethical, fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others.
3. Make a commitment to providing a quality service.
4. Operate within the rules and spirit of the sport including the Fusion Netball Club Academy Policies & Procedures which governs members of Fusion Netball Club and understand the repercussions if you breach or are aware of any breaches of the Policies & Procedures.
5. Do not use your involvement with netball to promote your own beliefs, behaviours or practices where these are inconsistent with those of Fusion Netball Club.



6. Demonstrate a high degree of individual responsibility especially when dealing with persons under 18 years of age, as your words and actions are an example.
7. Always place the safety and welfare of children above other considerations.
8. Avoid unaccompanied and unobserved activities with persons under 18 years of age, wherever possible.
9. Comply with all relevant Australian laws (Federal & State), particularly Anti-Discrimination and Child Protection Laws.
10. Refrain from any behaviour that may bring Fusion Netball Club into disrepute.
11. Provide a safe environment for the conduct of the activity. Show concern and caution towards others who may be sick or injured.
12. Be a positive role model.
13. Be responsible and accountable for your conduct.

COACH ROLE

As a coach your role is to be:

A teacher	passing on information and ideas;
A trainer	improving athlete skills;
A motivator	instilling a positive approach at all times;
A disciplinarian	firm but fair;
An organiser	preparing training plans;
An observer	error detecting and correcting;
A role model	setting an expected standard for athletes to follow;
A communicator	providing feedback to athletes, parents and mentors.
